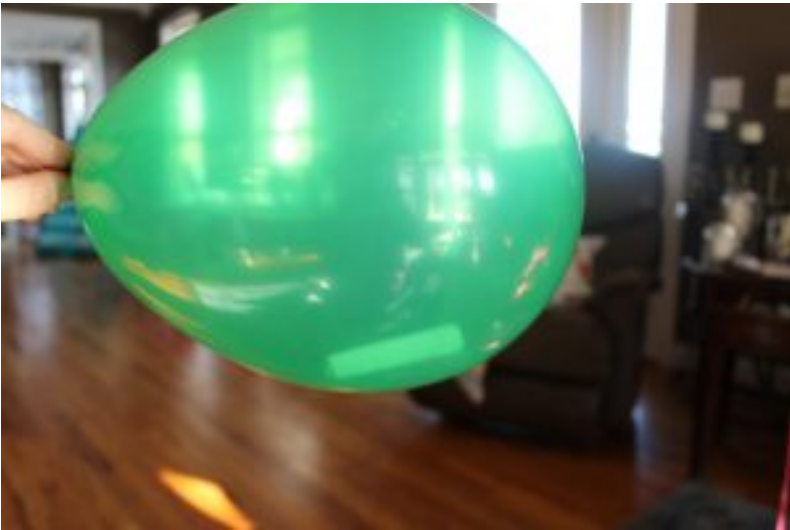


Letters mailed to Heaven
